WHY EXPEDITION CRUISING?

In the late 1960s, Lars-Eric Lindblad, the founder of expedition cruising, dreamt of finding 'unusual harbors whose secrets could be unveiled on an intimate basis for people who preferred learning with their travel'. Ships were old, comforts few, destinations limited. Much has changed in expedition cruising since then – the ships have become more comfortable and, as the emphasis has grown on sustainability, the race to become the first truly carbon neutral ship and brand is in full swing. However, the goal remains unchanged: to find and showcase unique, authentic corners of our beautiful planet and to enable guests to learn from expert expedition leaders while travelling on small ships.

The Arctic, Antarctica, and the Galapagos archipelago remain popular destinations, but this is changing too, and you can now travel to such remarkable places as Baja California to see the grey whale migration in the Sea of Cortez, or explore the Costa Rica and Panama coastlines both rich in marine and land based wildlife.
